## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 2 Statutes, further providing for the processing fee in lieu of 3 registration fee. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 1901 of Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read: § 1901. Exemption of entities and vehicles from fees. \* \* \* 10 11 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee. -- No registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any 12 13 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to 14 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the 15 registration: 16 (1) Hospital.

- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
- 27 apply to processing fees charged on January 1 of the year next
- 28 following the date of final enactment, and thereafter.
