AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for the processing fee in lieu of
3 registration fee.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 1901 of Title 75, act
7 of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:

9 § 1901. Exemption of entities and vehicles from fees.

11 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
12 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
13 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
14 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
15 registration:

16 (1) Hospital.

17 (2) Humane society.

18 (3) Nonprofit youth center.

- 1 (4) American Red Cross.
- 2 (5) Church.
- 3 (6) Girl Scouts of America.
- 4 (7) Boy Scouts of America.
- 5 (8) Salvation Army.
- 6 (9) Duly chartered posts of national veterans'
- 7 organizations.
- 8 (10) Young Men's Christian Association.
- 9 (11) Young Men's Hebrew Association.
- 10 (12) Young Women's Christian Association.
- 11 (13) Young Women's Hebrew Association.
- 12 (14) Jewish Community Center.
- 13 (15) Nonprofit corporations of musical marching groups
- 14 of youths.
- 15 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social
- 16 security or other pension and whose total income does not
- 17 exceed [\$7,500] \$8,999 per year. Unless the retired person is
- 18 physically or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the
- 19 retired person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle
- 20 but may from time to time authorize another person to drive
- 21 the vehicle in his or her stead.
- 22 (17) Any veteran who lost a limb or eye or who became
- 23 partially paralyzed while serving in the armed forces of the
- 24 United States.

26 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
27 apply to processing fees charged on January 1 of the year next
28 following the date of final enactment, and thereafter.
