AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), entitled 2 "An act specifically authorizing collective bargaining 3 between policemen and firemen and their public employers; 4 providing for arbitration in order to settle disputes, and requiring compliance with collective bargaining agreements and findings of arbitrators," further providing for the 6 7 payment of arbitration expenses. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 8, act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, 10 No.111), referred to as the Policemen and Firemen Collective 11 12 Bargaining Act, is amended to read: 13 Section 8. [The compensation, if any, of the arbitrator 14 appointed by the policemen or firemen shall be paid by them. The 15 compensation of the other two arbitrators, as well as all 16 stenographic and other expenses incurred by the arbitration 17 panel in connection with the arbitration proceedings, shall be paid by the political subdivision or by the Commonwealth, as the 18

case may be.] The compensation of the arbitrators as well as all

stenographic and other expenses incurred by the arbitration

- 1 panel in connection with the arbitration proceedings, shall be
- 2 paid equally by the political subdivision or the Commonwealth,
- 3 and by the policemen or firemen, as the case may be.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
