## AN ACT

Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing an additional limitation on creditable 3 nonschool service. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 8304(b)(A) of Title 24, act of November 6 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes, is amended AND SUBSECTION (B) IS AMENDED by adding a paragraph to read: 10 § 8304. Creditable nonschool service. \* \* \* 11 12 (A) ELIGIBILITY. -- AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A MULTIPLE SERVICE 13 MEMBER WHO IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE STATE EMPLOYEES' 14 RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE CLASS T-C SERVICE 15 CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE NONSCHOOL SERVICE AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (B) PROVIDED THAT HE IS NOT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE, 16

ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE NOW OR IN THE FUTURE, OR IS RECEIVING

- 1 RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR SUCH SERVICE UNDER A RETIREMENT SYSTEM
- 2 ADMINISTERED AND WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY PAID FOR BY ANY OTHER
- 3 GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR BY ANY PRIVATE EMPLOYER, OR A RETIREMENT
- 4 PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE EMPLOYER IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
- 5 8301(A)(1) (RELATING TO MANDATORY AND OPTIONAL MEMBERSHIP), AND
- 6 FURTHER PROVIDED THAT SUCH SERVICE IS CERTIFIED BY THE PREVIOUS
- 7 EMPLOYER AND THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT DUE IS AGREED
- 8 UPON BY THE MEMBER, THE EMPLOYER, AND THE BOARD. HOWEVER, AN
- 9 ACTIVE MEMBER WHO IS NOT ACTUALLY RECEIVING BENEFITS FROM A
- 10 RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF ANOTHER STATE MAY DIVEST HIMSELF OF HIS
- 11 ENTITLEMENT OR ELIGIBILITY FOR FUTURE BENEFITS IN THAT SYSTEM IN
- 12 ORDER TO RECEIVE CREDITABLE NONSCHOOL SERVICE CREDIT UNDER
- 13 SUBSECTION (B)(3). SUCH DIVESTITURE SHALL BE CERTIFIED TO THE
- 14 BOARD BY THE OUT-OF-STATE SYSTEM BEFORE THE MEMBER APPLIES FOR
- 15 THE CREDITABLE NONSCHOOL SERVICE CREDIT.
- 16 (b) Limitations on nonschool service.--Creditable nonschool
- 17 service credit shall be limited to:

- 19 (6) Previous work experience as required for permanent
- 20 <u>certification as a vocational teacher: Provided, That for</u>
- 21 <u>every three years or major fraction thereof an individual can</u>
- 22 buy one year of creditable service, not to exceed a total of
- five years. PREVIOUS WORK EXPERIENCE SHALL NOT INCLUDE TIME

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- 24 SERVED IN AN APPRENTICESHIP. THE PURCHASE OF THIS SERVICE
- 25 SHALL BEGIN WITHIN THREE YEARS OF THE EMPLOYEE'S ELIGIBILITY
- 26 <u>TO PURCHASE THIS CREDITABLE SERVICE.</u>

- 28 SECTION 2. SECTION 8324 OF TITLE 24 IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
- 29 SUBSECTION TO READ:
- 30 § 8324. CONTRIBUTIONS FOR PURCHASE OF CREDIT FOR CREDITABLE

- 1 NONSCHOOL SERVICE.

- 3 (E) CREDITABLE WORK EXPERIENCE. -- FOR THE CALCULATION OF THE
- 4 EMPLOYER'S SHARE OF THE CONTRIBUTION FOR SERVICE LISTED IN
- 5 SECTION 8304(B)(6) (RELATING TO CREDITABLE NONSCHOOL SERVICE)
- THE RATE SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE FULL COST OF THE SERVICE CREDITS 6
- CALCULATED ON THE BASIS OF THE ASSUMPTIONS USED FOR PURPOSES OF 7
- 8 THE ACTUARIAL VALUATION OF THE SYSTEM'S LIABILITIES. IT SHALL
- TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE ADDITIONAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE ARISING ON
- 10 ACCOUNT OF SUCH ADDITIONAL SERVICE CREDIT COMMENCING AT THE
- 11 EARLIEST AGE AT WHICH SUCH MEMBER COULD RETIRE ON AN UNREDUCED
- 12 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES UPON
- 13 THE ADVICE OF THE CONSULTING ACTUARY. ANY INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBLE TO
- 14 RECEIVE AN ANNUITY, EXCLUDING AN ANNUITY RECEIVED UNDER THE
- 15 FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1936, AS AMENDED (42 U.S.C. §
- 16 301, ET. SEO.), IN ANOTHER PENSION SYSTEM, OTHER THAN A MILITARY

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- 17 PENSION SYSTEM, SHALL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE THIS SERVICE.
- 18 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect in 60 days.
