1 2 3 4	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, extending a police officer's power of arrest and custody beyond the limits of the officer's political subdivision.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
8	No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
9	amended by adding a section to read:
10	§ 8902. Duration of intrastate arrest and custody powers.
11	Irrespective of the territorial limits of a political
12	subdivision, the police officer's power of arrest and custody
13	shall be effective from the time of an arrest to the time of
14	incarceration or the setting of bail. Officers holding an
15	individual in custody in a political subdivision other than the
16	one in which the arrest occurred shall have the power of arrest
17	over that individual to the same extent as it is available to
18	police officers of that subdivision.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
