## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 extraordinary jurisdiction of the Supreme Court.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 726 of Title 42, act of November 25, 1970
- 7 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 726. Extraordinary jurisdiction.
- 10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Supreme Court
- 11 may, on its own motion or upon petition of any party, in any
- 12 matter pending before any court or district justice of this
- 13 Commonwealth involving an issue of immediate public importance,
- 14 assume plenary jurisdiction of such matter at any stage thereof
- 15 and enter a final order or otherwise cause right and justice to
- 16 be done. Such plenary jurisdiction shall be exercised only by
- 17 the Supreme Court and may not be delegated or transferred.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
