- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing fishing license fees.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Sections 2701 and 2702 of Title 30, act of
- 6 November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, added October 16, 1980 (P.L.996, No.175),
- 8 are amended to read:
- 9 § 2701. Resident fishing licenses.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- For the purposes of this chapter any
- 11 person 16 years of age or older is entitled to a "Resident
- 12 Fishing License" if:
- 13 (1) He has applied to an issuing agent within this
- 14 Commonwealth or to the commission.
- 15 (2) He has established his identity, age and the fact
- that he is a bona fide resident of this Commonwealth to the
- 17 satisfaction of the issuing agent or the commission by

- 1 producing a motor vehicle driver's license or some other
- 2 positive means of identification.
- 3 (3) He has paid the issuing agent or the commission a
- 4 license fee of [\$9] \$12 plus a service fee of 25ç to the
- 5 issuing agent.
- 6 (b) Senior citizens.--A person 65 years of age or older at
- 7 the time of application who complies with subsection (a)(1) and
- 8 (2) is entitled to a "Senior Resident Fishing License" if he
- 9 pays a license fee of [\$2] \$4 to the issuing agent or the
- 10 commission plus a service fee of 25¢ to the issuing agent. The
- 11 application shall give the date of birth of the applicant. Any
- 12 person who qualifies to purchase a Senior Resident Fishing
- 13 License may, in lieu thereof, purchase a Senior Resident Fishing
- 14 License which shall be valid for his lifetime upon the payment
- of a fee of [\$10] \$20 for the use of the Commonwealth and, in
- 16 the event the license is issued by an issuing agent, a fee of
- 17 25¢ for the use of the issuing agent.
- 18 § 2702. Nonresident and tourist licenses.
- 19 (a) Nonresident licenses. -- For the purposes of this chapter
- 20 any person 16 years of age or older is entitled to a
- 21 "Nonresident Fishing License" if:
- 22 (1) He is not a bona fide resident of this Commonwealth.
- 23 (2) He has applied to an issuing agent or to the
- 24 commission.
- 25 (3) He has paid the issuing agent or the commission a
- license fee of [\$14] <u>\$20</u> plus a service fee of 25¢ to the
- 27 issuing agent.
- 28 (b) Tourist licenses. -- For the purposes of this chapter any
- 29 person 16 years of age or older is entitled to a "Seven Day
- 30 Tourist Fishing License, "valid for a period of seven

- 1 consecutive days, if:
- 2 (1) He is not a bona fide resident of this Commonwealth.
- 3 (2) He has applied to an issuing agent or to the
- 4 commission.
- 5 (3) He has paid the issuing agent or the commission a
- 6 license fee of [\$9] <u>\$15</u> plus a service charge of 25¢ to the
- 7 issuing agent.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
