AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for vehicle titles and increasing
- 3 certain penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1103(d) of Title 75, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 1103. Application for certificate of title.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (d) Vehicles purchased from dealers.--If the application
- 12 refers to a vehicle purchased from a dealer, the dealer shall
- 13 mail or deliver the application to the department within ten
- 14 days of the date of purchase. The application shall contain the
- 15 names and addresses of any lienholders in order of priority, the
- 16 amounts and the dates of the security agreements, and be
- 17 assigned by the dealer to the owner and signed by the owner. The
- 18 application shall be accompanied by two checks of the purchaser

- 1 payable to the Department of Revenue for the amount of the sales
- 2 tax and payable to the Department of Transportation for the
- 3 amount of the appropriate fees. Any dealer violating this
- 4 subsection is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon
- 5 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of [\$50] \$500 for each
- 6 violation. The requirement that the dealer mail or deliver the
- 7 application to the department does not apply to vehicles
- 8 purchased by fleet owners or governmental or quasi-governmental
- 9 agencies.

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
