AN ACT

Amending the act of July 24, 1970 (P.L.620, No.208), entitled "An act providing for the adoption of minors and adults and for the termination of certain parent-child relationships; 4 providing for jurisdiction of courts; providing for recording of foreign decrees of adoption; and containing provisions for 6 procedures, decrees and records in all matters relating 7 thereto," providing for the irrevocability of consents to 8 adoption. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of July 24, 1970 (P.L.620, No.208), known 12 as the "Adoption Act," is amended by adding a section to read: 13 Section 415. Consent Irrevocable. -- (a) A consent shall, thirty days from the date of execution, be irrevocable and the 14 15 court shall not have jurisdiction to invalidate an irrevocable 16 consent in the absence of fraud. The burden of proving fraud 17 shall be on the party seeking to invalidate the consent. (b) A consent shall contain a written statement of the 18
