AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of June 7, 1911 (P.L.677, No.267), entitled  
2 "An act to require fire drills in factories and industrial  
3 establishments, where women or girls are employed; providing  
4 for the promulgation of rules in respect thereto, and  
5 providing penalties for the violation thereof."

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of June 7, 1911 (P.L.677, No.267),  
9 entitled "An act to require fire drills in factories and  
10 industrial establishments, where women or girls are employed;  
11 providing for the promulgation of rules in respect thereto, and  
12 providing penalties for the violation thereof," is repealed.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
