AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of June 3, 1893 (P.L.276, No.244), entitled
2 "An act to regulate the employment and provide for the safety
3 of women and children in manufacturing establishments,
4 mercantile industries, laundry or renovating establishments,
5 and to provide for the appointment of inspectors to enforce
6 the same, and other acts providing for the safety or
7 regulating the employment of said persons."

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1893 (P.L.276, No.244),
11 entitled "An act to regulate the employment and provide for the
12 safety of women and children in manufacturing establishments,
13 mercantile industries, laundry or renovating establishments, and
14 to provide for the appointment of inspectors to enforce the
15 same, and other acts providing for the safety or regulating the
16 employment of said persons," is repealed.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
