AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of October 20, 1966 (3rd Sp.Sess., P.L.96,
- No.6), entitled "An act relating to mental health and mental
- 3 retardation; authorizing county programs and amending,
- 4 revising and changing the laws relating thereto and making an
- 5 appropriation," limiting the amount a governmental body may
- 6 withhold from income of mentally disabled persons.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 501, act of October 20, 1966 (3rd
- 10 Sp.Sess., P.L.96, No.6), known as the "Mental Health and Mental
- 11 Retardation Act of 1966," is amended to read:
- 12 Section 501. Liability of Mentally Disabled Persons. --
- 13 Whenever public funds are expended under any provision of this
- 14 act on behalf of a mentally disabled person, the governmental
- 15 body expending such funds may recover the same from such person
- 16 subject to the regulations of the department and for this
- 17 purpose liability is hereby imposed upon such person admitted,
- 18 committed or otherwise receiving any service or benefit under
- 19 this act for all costs, payments or expenditures with reference

- 1 thereto, including but not being limited to the costs of
- 2 admission or commitment, transportation, treatment, training,
- 3 maintenance, complete care, partial care or aftercare and
- 4 discharge. Mentally disabled persons receiving monthly pension
- 5 <u>checks shall have no liability other than a maximum of ten</u>
- 6 percent of their income for services provided or funded by
- 7 State, county or other governmental agency. An interested and
- 8 responsible relative or guardian is encouraged to seek priority
- 9 for determining and channeling the use of the balance of their
- 10 <u>incomes</u>.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
