AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for incest.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 4302 of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 6 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 8 § 4302. Incest.
- 9 A person is guilty of incest, a misdemeanor of the first
- 10 degree, if he knowingly marries or cohabits or has sexual
- 11 intercourse with an ancestor or descendant, a brother or sister
- 12 of the whole or half blood [or], an uncle, aunt, nephew or niece
- 13 of the whole blood or a stepson or stepdaughter. The
- 14 relationships referred to in this section include blood
- 15 relationships without regard to legitimacy, [and] the
- 16 relationship of parent and child by adoption and the
- 17 relationship between a person and the child of a spouse by a

- 1 <u>former marriage</u>.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days and shall
- 3 apply to offenses committed on and after such date.
