## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act providing property tax or rent 2 3 rebate and inflation dividends to certain senior citizens, widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with 5 limited incomes; establishing uniform standards and 6 qualifications for eligibility to receive rebates and 7 dividends; providing for transportation assistance grants and grants to area agencies on aging for services to older persons; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue," 9 providing for a further grant to senior citizens. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 12 13 Section 1. Section 4, act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), 14 known as the "Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act," reenacted and amended June 16, 1975 (P.L.7, No.4), is amended by 15 16 adding a subsection to read: 17 Section 4. Property Tax; Rent Rebate and Inflation Cost. --\* \* \* 18 (a.4) To all claimants eligible for a property tax or rent 19 20 rebate for real property taxes or rent due and payable during calendar year 1980 there shall be paid one hundred dollars 21
