AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the
- 3 imposition of sentences in certain convictions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 9763. Sentence for multiple violations.
- 10 After a determination of guilt involving a defendant charged
- 11 with multiple violations of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2504 (relating to
- 12 <u>involuntary manslaughter</u>) or 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732 (relating to
- 13 homicide by vehicle), the court imposing sentence shall have the
- 14 authority and may impose a specific sentence for each violation

- 1 of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2504 or 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732 for which a
- 2 <u>determination of guilt has been returned</u>.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
