16	hereby enacts as follows:
17	Section 1. The act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known
18	as the "Public Employe Relations Act," is amended by adding a
19	section to read:
20	Section 1802. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
21	prohibit an employe bargaining unit from establishing a
22	voluntary Political Action Fund. To this end, the employe

bargaining unit may make use of payroll deductions so long as

- individual employes give prior written authorization for the 1
- 2 <u>deduction</u> and provisions are made allowing the employe to
- 3 terminate his deduction schedule on thirty days notice. The
- 4 <u>employe bargaining unit shall reimburse the public employer for</u>
- the cost of such deductions. 5
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
