- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the expungement
- 3 of criminal records.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 9122(b) of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 9122. Expungement.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (b) Generally.--Criminal history record information may be
- 12 expunged when:
- 13 (1) an individual who is the subject of the information
- 14 reaches 70 years of age and has been free of arrest or
- 15 prosecution for ten years following final release from
- 16 confinement or supervision; [or]
- 17 (2) an individual who is the subject of the information
- has been dead for three years[.]; or

- 1 (3) an individual who is the subject of the information
- 2 was convicted of a misdemeanor violation and has been free of
- arrest or prosecution for 15 years following final release 3
- from confinement or supervision. 4

- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 6
