L5	Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 13, act of April 14,
L6	1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug
L7	Device and Cosmetic Act," is amended by adding a clause and the

- 3 (k) Any person who violates clause (36) shall, upon
