REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, FEBRUARY 9, 1981

In the House of Representatives, February 9, 1981

1 WHEREAS, The Governor has recently issued an executive order  
2 to phase out State operated farming on State lands adjacent to  
3 State mental hospitals and State centers for the mentally  
4 retarded; and

5 WHEREAS, Situate on such lands are many buildings and other  
6 structures which may have historical or architectural  
7 significance; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the House of  
9 Representatives does hereby urge the Department of General  
10 Services to inventory all buildings and structures related to  
11 State farming operations as aforesaid; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That this inventory be immediately transmitted to  
13 the Historical and Museum Commission and that the commission  
14 evaluate each building and structure for possible inclusion on  
15 the appropriate Federal or State register relating to historic  
16 or architecturally significant buildings and structures; and be

2 RESOLVED, That the commission submit a report to the General  
3 Assembly on the results of this request as soon as practicable.
