2 freedom is your freedom," have sought liberty for themselves,  
3 other people and especially the citizens of the United States  
4 through persons such as Generals Kosciuszko and Pulaski; and

5 WHEREAS, The people of Poland, united in the Solidarity  
6 Independent Trade Union, are dramatically and peacefully  
7 struggling for the right of collective bargaining; and

8 WHEREAS, The farmers and laborers of Poland are striving for  
9 a humanistic and spiritual way of life, which is counter to  
10 Soviet ideology; and

11 WHEREAS, The ~~Polanders~~ PEOPLE OF POLAND are suffering from  
12 food shortages and economic deprivation; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the  
14 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorializes the President and the

3       RESOLVED, That the President of the United States give aid to  
4 the people of Poland, especially in the United Nations; and be

8 resolution to the President of the United States and the
