In the House of Representatives, October 28, 1981

1 WHEREAS, Decontrol of natural gas prices has caused severe  
2 hardships for industry and homeowners and increase unemployment  
3 in Pennsylvania; and

4 WHEREAS, The northeastern states have been particularly hard  
5 hit by higher natural gas prices because of harsh winters and  
6 the concentration of manufacturing companies which depend on  
7 natural gas for processing; and

8 WHEREAS, Decontrol of natural gas prices has pushed homeowner  
9 costs three and four times higher than when they were  
10 controlled; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly  
12 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the President  
13 and the United States Congress to repeal the act of November 9,  
14 1978 Public Law 95-621, known as the Natural Gas Policy Act of  
15 1978; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That copies of this document be transmitted to the

- 1 President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States
- 2 House of Representatives and the President of the United States
- 3 Senate and to each Senator and Congressman from Pennsylvania.
