INTRODUCED BY BROWN AND PRATT, FEBRUARY 23, 1982

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL-STATE RELATIONS,
FEBRUARY 23, 1982

In the House of Representatives, February 23, 1982

1 The Federal Government is responsible for the siting and
2 construction of nuclear power plants; and

3 The Federal Government has set the precedent for financial
4 aid to corporations as evidenced by recent dealings with
5 Lockheed and Chrysler corporations; and

6 The accident at Three Mile Island has been the worst nuclear
7 accident both emotionally and financially in the history of
8 nuclear power; and

9 The present economy in Central Pennsylvania is suffering from
10 the dual curses of inflation and recession; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Federal Government enact legislation to
12 provide tax credits to Metropolitan Edison Company ratepayers
13 equalling the amount of money it will cost each consumer for the
14 accident at Three Mile Island effective with the next fiscal
15 year; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to the

1 presiding officers of each House of the Congress of the United
2 States and to each Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania
3 in the Congress of the United States.
