In the House of Representatives, September 29, 1982

- 1 WHEREAS, The United States Fish and Wildlife Service
- 2 establishes the duration of hunting seasons for migratory game
- 3 birds; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Game Commission establishes its
- 5 waterfowl season based on the United States Fish and Wildlife
- 6 Service's guidelines; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The United States Fish and Wildlife Service's
- 8 migratory waterfowl season is based on consecutive days and does
- 9 not take into consideration hunting days lost by states which
- 10 prohibit hunting on Sundays; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hunters lose several days of waterfowl
- 12 hunting annually because the Pennsylvania Game Commission
- 13 prohibits such hunting on Sundays; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby
- 15 memorialize the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to amend
- 16 its regulations to permit all states to fully utilize the number

- 1 of hunting days in the Federal migratory waterfowl hunting
- 2 season by permitting states to use their allocated number of
- 3 waterfowl hunting days within a broader time frame than current
- 4 regulations allow beginning with the 1983-1984 hunting season.
