In the House of Representatives, September 29, 1982

1 WHEREAS, The United States Fish and Wildlife Service
2 establishes the duration of hunting seasons for migratory game
3 birds; and

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Game Commission establishes its
5 waterfowl season based on the United States Fish and Wildlife
6 Service's guidelines; and

7 WHEREAS, The United States Fish and Wildlife Service's
8 migratory waterfowl season is based on consecutive days and does
9 not take into consideration hunting days lost by states which
10 prohibit hunting on Sundays; and

11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hunters lose several days of waterfowl
12 hunting annually because the Pennsylvania Game Commission
13 prohibits such hunting on Sundays; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby
15 memorialize the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to amend
16 its regulations to permit all states to fully utilize the number

1 of hunting days in the Federal migratory waterfowl hunting
2 season by permitting states to use their allocated number of
3 waterfowl hunting days within a broader time frame than current
4 regulations allow beginning with the 1983-1984 hunting season.
