AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
2 East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum of \$1,993,000 is hereby specifically
6 appropriated to The Medical College of Pennsylvania located in
7 East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for its fiscal period
8 July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982 for instruction in the Doctor of
9 Medicine program.

10 Section 2. The sum of \$260,000 is hereby appropriated to The
11 Medical College of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for
12 the fiscal period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982, for the general
13 maintenance of The Medical College of Pennsylvania including the
14 School of Allied Health and student aid.

15 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
16 on account of the appropriation for instruction in the Doctor of
17 Medicine program as provided in section 1 shall be made by the

1 Secretary of Education on the basis of full-time student
2 enrollment at the rate of \$4,400 per student.

3 Section 4. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania
4 on account of the appropriation for the School of Allied Health
5 as provided in section 2 shall be made by the Secretary of
6 Education on the basis of costs during the fiscal year.

7 Section 5. The college shall provide such information as may
8 be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act and in such
9 form and manner as the Department of Education may prescribe.

10 Section 6. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report
11 its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
12 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
13 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
14 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975" without
15 exception.

16 Section 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
