AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 22, 1981 (No.142), entitled "An act
2 requiring the termination of certain agencies of State
3 Government under certain circumstances, creating a Leadership
4 Committee with certain powers and duties and imposing powers
5 and duties upon the Legislative Budget and Finance
6 Committee," further providing for the powers and duties of
7 the Leadership Committee ~~and~~, making an editorial change AND <—
8 MAKING REPEALS.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Paragraph (3) of section 4 and ~~subsection (a)~~ <—
12 SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) of section 6, act of December 22, 1981 <—
13 (P.L.508, No.142), known as the "Sunset Act," are amended to
14 read:

15 Section 4. Powers and duties of the Leadership Committee.

16 The committee shall have the power and its duty shall be:

18 (3) [To utilize and assign the staff of the Legislative
19 Budget and Finance Committee, for the purpose of conducting
20 performance audits, which duty shall be the priority of the

Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.] To assign tasks to the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee for the purpose of conducting PERFORMANCE audits. Such tasks shall receive priority from the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.

Section 6. Termination of agencies.

7 SECTION 2. (A) SECTION 11 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 20, 1978 <—
8 (P.L.477, NO.70), ENTITLED "AN ACT AMENDING THE ACT OF APRIL 9,
9 1929 (P.L.177, NO.175), ENTITLED 'AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AND
10 REORGANIZING THE CONDUCT OF THE EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE
11 WORK OF THE COMMONWEALTH BY THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT THEREOF AND
12 THE ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND
13 OFFICERS THEREOF, INCLUDING THE BOARDS OF TRUSTEES OF STATE
14 NORMAL SCHOOLS, OR TEACHERS COLLEGES; ABOLISHING, CREATING,
15 REORGANIZING OR AUTHORIZING THE REORGANIZATION OF CERTAIN
16 ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS; DEFINING
17 THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE GOVERNOR AND OTHER EXECUTIVE AND
18 ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, AND OF THE SEVERAL ADMINISTRATIVE
19 DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND OFFICERS; FIXING THE
20 SALARIES OF THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, AND CERTAIN OTHER
21 EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS; PROVIDING FOR THE
22 APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, AND OF ALL
23 DEPUTIES AND OTHER ASSISTANTS AND EMPLOYES IN CERTAIN
24 DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS; AND PRESCRIBING THE MANNER
25 IN WHICH THE NUMBER AND COMPENSATION OF THE DEPUTIES AND ALL
26 OTHER ASSISTANTS AND EMPLOYES OF CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS AND
27 COMMISSIONS SHALL BE DETERMINED,' CREATING THE DEPARTMENT OF
28 AGING AND PRESCRIBING ITS FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES," IS
29 REPEALED.

30 (B) SECTION 12 OF THE ACT OF NOVEMBER 22, 1978 (P.L.1166,

1 NO.274), ENTITLED "AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE PENNSYLVANIA
2 COMMISSION ON CRIME AND DELINQUENCY, PROVIDING FOR ITS POWERS
3 AND DUTIES ESTABLISHING SEVERAL ADVISORY COMMITTEES WITHIN THE
4 COMMISSION AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR POWERS AND DUTIES," IS
5 REPEALED.

6 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
