AN ACT

1 Designating Lincoln University a land grant institution.

2 An Act of Congress, passed August 30, 1890, known as the
3 Second Morrill Act (7 U.S.C. § 321, et seq.), providing for the
4 further endowment and support of colleges of agriculture and
5 mechanical arts.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has
7 recognized and is now aiding Lincoln University as an integral
8 part of a system of higher education in Pennsylvania, under the
9 act of July 7, 1972 (P.L.743, No.176), known as the Lincoln
10 University--Commonwealth Act, pursuant to the requirements of
11 the Second Morrill Act for designation ~~of an institution as a~~ AS ←
12 AN 1890 land grant institution.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Lincoln University is hereby designated a AN 1890 ←
16 land grant institution eligible to receive endowments and

1 support as provided in the act of August 30, 1890, known as the
2 Second Morrill Act (7 U.S.C. § 321, et seq.).

3 ~~Section 2. All funds received by the Commonwealth of~~ <—
4 ~~Pennsylvania pursuant to the Second Morrill Act shall be divided~~
5 ~~equitably between the Pennsylvania State University and Lincoln~~
6 ~~University.~~

7 ~~Section 3. A copy of this act shall be transmitted to the~~
8 ~~Secretary of the United States Department of Education.~~

9 ~~Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.~~

10 SECTION 2. LINCOLN UNIVERSITY SHALL BE THE RECIPIENT OF SUCH <—
11 FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AS
12 ARE AUTHORIZED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES SOLELY AND
13 EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE LAND GRANT ACTIVITIES OF
14 COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDS UNDER THE
15 SECOND MORRILL ACT; SECTIONS 1444 AND 1445 OF PUBLIC LAW 95-113;
16 SECTIONS 1431, 1432 AND 1533 OF PUBLIC LAW 97-98; AND ANY
17 SUBSEQUENT FEDERAL LEGISLATION WHICH AUTHORIZES APPROPRIATIONS
18 SOLELY AND EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES
19 ELIGIBLE UNDER THE SECOND MORRILL ACT.

20 SECTION 3. THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY, AS THE 1862
21 LAND GRANT INSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
22 UNDER THE ACT OF JULY 1, 1862, KNOWN AS THE MORRILL ACT (7
23 U.S.C. § 301 ET SEQ.), SHALL BE THE RECIPIENT OF ALL FEDERAL
24 FUNDS ALLOCATED TO OR FOR THE USE OF AN 1862 LAND GRANT
25 INSTITUTION IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, EXCEPT AS
26 PROVIDED IN SECTION 2.

27 SECTION 4. LINCOLN UNIVERSITY MAY RECEIVE FUNDS PURSUANT TO
28 THE SECOND MORRILL ACT TO PROVIDE LAND GRANT EDUCATIONAL,
29 RESEARCH OR EXTENSION PROGRAMS, SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES WHICH ARE
30 NOT IN SUBSTANTIAL DUPLICATION OF OR IN SUBSTANTIAL COMPETITION

1 WITH THE LAND GRANT EDUCATIONAL, RESEARCH OR EXTENSION PROGRAMS,
2 SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES OF THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY.

3 SECTION 5. A COPY OF THIS ACT SHALL BE TRANSMITTED TO THE
4 SECRETARY OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

5 SECTION 6. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
