## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1959, No.657), entitled, as amended, "An act fixing the salaries and 2 3 compensation of the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court, the President Judge and judges of the Superior Court, 5 the judges of the courts of common pleas, the judges of the orphans' courts, the judges of the County Court of 7 Philadelphia and the judges of the County Court and Juvenile Court of Allegheny County, certain associate judges not 8 9 learned in the law, certain state officers, and the salary and expenses of the members of the General Assembly, and 10 repealing certain inconsistent acts," increasing salaries of 11 12 Philadelphia Traffic Court judges. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. Section 4.2 of the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1959, No.657), referred to as the Public Official 16 Compensation Law, amended October 25, 1979 (P.L.235, No.75), is 17 18 amended to read: 19 Section 4.2. The annual salary of the President Judge of the 20 Philadelphia Traffic Court shall be [twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000)] thirty-nine thousand dollars (\$39,000). The annual 21 salary of associate judges of the Philadelphia Traffic Court 22

- 1 shall be [twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)] thirty-five
- 2 thousand dollars (\$35,000).
- Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1983. 3
