| 1 2 3 4 5 | Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Governor and the Department of Environmental Resources, to convey a tract of land in Lower Yoder Township, Cambria County, in exchange for another tract located in the same township. |
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| 6 | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania |
| 7 | hereby enacts as follows: |
| 8 | Section 1. The Department of General Services, with the |
| 9 | approval of the Governor and the Department of Environmental |
| 10 | Resources, is hereby authorized to convey to the Piney Run |
| 11 | Mining Company the following described tract number 1 in |
| 12 | exchange for tracts numbers 2 and 3 located in Lower Yoder |
| 13 | Township, Cambria County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded |
| 14 | and described as follows: |
| 15 | Tract No. 1 |
| 16 | Beginning at a point at a corner of the Potts and Bheam, Alex |
| 17 | Stackhouse and Frederick Brehm tract; thence north 56 degrees 27 |
| 18 | minutes west 2007.3 feet to a point on the line of the J. P. |

McConnaughy Estate tract; thence by the line of the J. P.

- 1 McConnaughy Estate tract north 35 degrees 35 minutes east 1400
- 2 feet thence through the Potts and Bheam tract of which this is a
- 3 part, south 56 degrees 27 minutes east 2007.3 feet to a point on
- 4 the line of the Alex Stackhouse tract; thence by the line of the
- 5 Alex Stackhouse tract south 34 degrees 49 minutes west 1400 feet
- 6 to the place of beginning. Containing 65 acres, more or less.
- 7 Title to which became vested in the Commonwealth of
- 8 Pennsylvania by deed of the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy
- 9 recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 866, Page 72, which
- 10 title does not include oil and gas rights, together with the
- 11 associated rights of producing, transporting, introducing,
- 12 storing and withdrawing oil and gas. Excepting and reserving any
- 13 mineral rights the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania may have
- 14 acquired through deed of the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy
- 15 recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 886, Page 72,
- 16 together with all rights necessary or convenient for the removal
- 17 of said minerals.
- 18 Tract No. 2
- 19 Beginning at Stones at the corner of the David Gates tract
- 20 and Frederick Brehm tract and the J. P. McConnaughy Estate
- 21 tract; thence by line of the J. P. McConnaughy Estate tract
- 22 north 34 degrees 43 minutes east 4390 feet to a point and north
- 23 35 degrees 35 minutes east 115.5 feet to a point on the line of
- 24 the Potts and Bheam tract; thence by the Potts and Bheam tract
- 25 south 56 degrees 27 minutes east 750 feet to a point; thence
- 26 through the Frederick Brehm tract of which this formerly was a
- 27 part, south 34 degrees 43 minutes west 4505.5 feet to a point on
- 28 line of the David Gates tract; thence by line of the David Gates
- 29 tract north 56 degrees 27 minutes west 750 feet to Stones and
- 30 place of beginning. Containing 75 acres. Except and reserving

- 1 all the oil and gas underlying said land, together with all
- 2 rights necessary or convenient for the removal of said oil and
- 3 gas.
- 4 Being a part of a larger tract of land conveyed to the Piney
- 5 Run Mining Company by deed of W. David Lloyd, dated September
- 6 13, 1917 and recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 292,
- 7 Page 608.
- 8 Tract No. 3
- 9 Beginning at Stones at the corner of the Edward Lewis tract,
- 10 Alex Stackhouse tract and Potts and Bheam tract thence by the
- 11 Potts and Bheam tract north 33 degrees 50 minutes east 2611.5
- 12 feet to a post on line of the George Bumbernick tract; thence by
- 13 the George Bumbernick tract south 54 degrees 8 minutes east
- 14 377.8 feet to a point; then through the Edward Lewis tract of
- 15 which this was formerly a part south 33 degrees 50 minutes west
- 16 2611.5 feet to a point on the line of the Alex Stackhouse tract;
- 17 thence by the Alex Stackhouse tract north 55 degrees 27 minutes
- 18 west 377.8 feet to stones in the place of beginning. Containing
- 19 22 acres. Except and reserving all oil and gas underlying said
- 20 land, together with all rights necessary or convenient for the
- 21 removal of said oil and gas.
- 22 Being a part of a larger tract of land conveyed to the Piney
- 23 Run Mining Company by deed of W. David Lloyd, dated September
- 24 13, 1917 and recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 292,
- 25 Page 608.
- 26 Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved as
- 27 provided by law and shall be executed by the Secretary of
- 28 General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of
- 29 Pennsylvania.
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
