AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 11, 1947 (P.L.538, No.246), entitled 2 "An act relating to the regulation of rates for insurance 3 which may be written by stock or mutual casualty insurance companies, associations or exchanges, including fidelity, 4 5 surety and quaranty bonds and all other forms of motor 6 vehicle insurance, and title insurance; to rating and advisory organizations; conferring on the Insurance Commissioner the power and duty of supervising and regulating 7 8 9 persons, associations, companies and corporations, and of enforcing the provisions of this act; prescribing and 10 regulating the practice and procedure before the 11 commissioner, and procedure for review by the courts; giving 12 13 the Court of Common Pleas of Dauphin County exclusive jurisdiction over certain proceedings; prescribing penalties 14 and providing for enforcement thereof, and repealing 15 inconsistent acts, "providing a criteria for the establishing 16 17 of rates for automobile liability insurance. 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 19 20 Section 1.
