## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), entitled "An act providing for the incorporation as bodies corporate and 3 politic of 'Authorities' for municipalities, counties and 4 townships; prescribing the rights, powers and duties of such Authorities heretofore or hereafter incorporated; authorizing 6 such Authorities to acquire, construct, improve, maintain and 7 operate projects, and to borrow money and issue bonds 8 therefor; providing for the payment of such bonds, and 9 prescribing the rights of the holders thereof; conferring the right of eminent domain on such Authorities; authorizing such 10 Authorities to enter into contracts with and to accept grants 11 from the Federal Government or any agency thereof; and 12 13 conferring exclusive jurisdiction on certain courts over rates," providing for the nonpayment of rentals or other sums 14 15 by eligible educational institutions. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 17 18 Section 1. The act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), known 19 as the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, is amended by 20 adding a section to read: 21 Section 4.1. Nonpayment of Rentals or Other Sums. -- A. In 22 all cases where an eligible educational institution fails to pay
- 24 sums due to any Authority in accordance with any lease or other

or provide for the payment of any rental or rentals or other

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- 1 contract entered into between the Authority and the institution,
- 2 the Authority shall give written notice of nonpayment by an
- 3 institution to the State Treasurer, the Executive Director of
- 4 the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency and the
- 5 <u>Secretary of Education</u>.
- 6 B. The State Treasurer, upon receipt of written notice from
- 7 <u>an Authority, may:</u>
- 8 (a) Notify the institution of its obligation and of the
- 9 <u>withholding provisions of this section</u>.
- 10 (b) Withhold, out of any State appropriations or other
- 11 grants or subsidies payable to the institution, an amount equal
- 12 to the unpaid rentals or other sums owed by the institution.
- (c) Request the Auditor General to issue a warrant for
- 14 payment to the Authority of the amount withheld. Upon receipt of
- 15 <u>a written request from the State Treasurer, the Auditor General</u>
- 16 shall issue to the State Treasurer a warrant for payment to the
- 17 Authority of the amount withheld. The State Treasurer shall pay
- 18 over the amount withheld to the Authority, and the Authority
- 19 shall apply that payment to the rental or other sums due from
- 20 <u>the institution</u>.
- 21 <u>C. If there is no State appropriation payable to the</u>
- 22 institution, or if the amount of the State appropriation is
- 23 insufficient to cover the amount of the unpaid rentals or other
- 24 <u>sums owed by the institution, the State Treasurer shall so</u>
- 25 inform the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Higher
- 26 Education Assistance Agency. The Executive Director, upon
- 27 receipt of written notice from the State Treasurer, may:
- 28 (a) Notify the institution of its obligation and of the
- 29 <u>withholding provisions of this section</u>.
- 30 (b) Withhold, out of any institutional assistance grants

- payable to the institution, as provided for by the act of July 1
- 2 <u>18, 1974 (P.L.483, No.174), known as "The Institutional</u>
- 3 Assistance Grants Act, " an amount equal to the unpaid rentals or
- 4 other sums owed by the institution. The Executive Director shall
- pay over the amount withheld to the Authority and the Authority 5
- shall apply that payment to the rentals or other sums due from 6
- 7 the institution.
- 8 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
