A SUPPLEMENT

- 1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act
- 2 providing for fiscal year 1983-1984," itemizing a capital
- 3 project in the Department of Education.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Total authorization.
- 7 The total authorization for a capital project in the category
- 8 of a public improvement project itemized in section 2 to be
- 9 acquired or constructed by the Department of General Services,
- 10 its successors or assigns and to be financed by the incurring of
- 11 debt shall be \$8,594,000.
- 12 Section 2. Itemization of project.
- 13 The individual capital project in the category of a public
- 14 improvement project to be acquired or constructed by the
- 15 Department of General Services, its successors or assigns and to
- 16 be financed by the incurring of debt is hereby itemized together
- 17 with its estimated financial costs as follows:

- 10 Section 3. Debt authorization.
- 11 The governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
- 12 authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in
- 13 addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted,
- 14 on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations
- 15 provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in
- 16 the aggregate the sum of \$8,594,000 as may be found necessary to
- 17 carry out the acquisition and construction of the public
- 18 improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.
- 19 Section 4. Issue of bonds.
- 20 The indebtedness herein authorized shall be incurred from
- 21 time to time and shall be evidenced by one or more series of
- 22 general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such aggregate
- 23 principal amount for each series as the Governor, Auditor
- 24 General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the latest
- 25 stated maturity date shall not exceed 30 years from the date of
- 26 the bond first issued for each such series.
- 27 Section 5. Appropriation.
- The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein
- 29 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 30 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount

- 1 of \$8,594,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the
- 2 financial cost of the public improvement projects specifically
- 3 itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or paying the
- 4 expenses of the sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer
- 5 shall pay to the Department of General Services the moneys as
- 6 required and certified by it to be legally due and payable.
- 7 Section 6. Estimated useful life of projects.
- 8 The General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the
- 9 public improvement projects heretofore itemized is not less than
- 10 30 years from the date of completion thereof, which period is
- 11 hereby stated to be the maximum term of the debt to be incurred.
- 12 Section 7. Federal funds.
- 13 In addition to those funds appropriated in section 6, all
- 14 moneys received from the Federal Government, if any, for the
- 15 construction of the public improvement projects specifically
- 16 itemized herein are also hereby appropriated for those projects.
- 17 Section 8. Allocation of funds.
- 18 Whenever, as determined by the Department of General
- 19 Services, the full estimated financial cost of the public
- 20 improvement projects itemized in section 1 hereof are not
- 21 necessary for the proper design, acquisition or construction of
- 22 the projects, the excess funds no longer required may be
- 23 allocated to increase the estimated cost of any one or more of
- 24 the public improvement projects specifically itemized in a
- 25 capital budget.
- 26 Section 9. Effective date.
- 27 This act shall take effect July 1, 1983 or, if enacted
- 28 subsequent to that date, then immediately.
