AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled  
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," changing the per diem rate for attendance of  
5 appointed township officers and employes at conferences,  
6 institutes and schools.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 624 of the act of June 24, 1931  
10 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,  
11 reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), and  
12 amended February 26, 1982 (P.L.93, No.35), is amended to read:

13 Section 624. Conferences, Institutes and Schools.--The  
14 expenses which shall be limited to the registration fee,  
15 mileage, and per diem up to [sixty dollars (\$60)] seventy-five  
16 dollars (\$75) per day, of elected or appointed township officers  
17 and employes may be paid by the township when authorized by the  
18 board of township commissioners to attend conferences,  
19 institutes and schools in order to discuss and resolve the

1 various questions arising in the discharge of the duties and  
2 functions of the respective officers and employes, and to  
3 provide uniform, efficient and economical methods of  
4 administering their township duties.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
