13	Section 624. Conferences, Institutes and SchoolsThe
14	expenses which shall be limited to the registration fee,
15	mileage, and per diem up to [sixty dollars (\$60)] <u>seventy-five</u>
16	dollars (\$75) per day, of elected or appointed township officers
17	and employes may be paid by the township when authorized by the
18	board of township commissioners to attend conferences,
19	institutes and schools in order to discuss and resolve the

various questions arising in the discharge of the duties and
functions of the respective officers and employes, and to
provide uniform, efficient and economical methods of
administering their township duties.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
