AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," providing for compensation of certain persons.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
15 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a
16 section to read:

17 Section 412.2. Compensation of Committeemen.--All duly
18 elected committeemen and committeewomen of any Pennsylvania
19 political party, except for members of State committees, shall
20 be mailed from the Secretary of the Commonwealth fifty (\$50)
21 dollars in expenses for each primary and fifty (\$50) dollars in
22 expenses for each election for the terms in which they are

1 elected, as long as they reside in the district from which they
2 are elected.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
