## AN ACT

- 1 Creating a Joint Legislative Committee to facilitate a regional
- 2 light rail transit system in the Lehigh Valley; providing for
- a feasibility study; and making an appropriation.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Establishment of committee.
- 7 A Joint Legislative Committee of the General Assembly is
- 8 hereby created for the purpose of conducting a feasibility study
- 9 of a proposed Lehigh Valley Regional Light Rail Transit System.
- 10 Section 2. Appointment and composition.
- 11 The committee shall be comprised of six members. Three
- 12 members of the House of Representatives, two from the majority
- 13 party and one from the minority party, shall be appointed by the
- 14 Speaker of the House of Representatives. Three members of the
- 15 Senate, two from the majority party and one from the minority
- 16 party, shall be appointed by the President pro tempore of the
- 17 Senate.

- 1 Section 3. Organizational meeting.
- 2 The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President
- 3 pro tempore of the Senate shall make their respective
- 4 appointments within 30 days of the effective date of this act.
- 5 The Speaker and President pro tempore shall jointly issue a call
- 6 for the organizational meeting of the committee within 30 days
- 7 from the date of the last appointment.
- 8 Section 4. Chairman and officers.
- 9 At the organizational meeting the committee shall elect a
- 10 chairman and vice chairman and any other officers it deems
- 11 necessary.
- 12 Section 5. Quorum and records.
- 13 A majority of the existing membership of the committee shall
- 14 constitute a quorum. A majority of those committee members
- 15 present and voting at meetings shall constitute a majority
- 16 necessary to pass motions. Records shall be kept of all votes
- 17 taken at formal meetings and the records shall be available for
- 18 public inspection.
- 19 Section 6. Transit system study.
- 20 Within 60 days of the organizational meeting of the Joint
- 21 Legislative Committee, the committee shall issue a request for
- 22 proposals for a study of the feasibility of the establishment
- 23 and operation of a Lehigh Valley Regional Light Rail Transit
- 24 System that would provide light rail transit service linking the
- 25 cities of Easton, Bethlehem and Allentown in the counties of
- 26 Northampton and Lehigh. This study shall include, but not be
- 27 limited to, the advantages of easing traffic congestion by the
- 28 utilization of light rail transportation; the lessening of
- 29 America's reliance on imported oil; the abatement of air, water
- 30 and noise pollution; the economic benefit to the region and its

- 1 taxpayers; the continued utilization of already existing track
- 2 and facilities; and the lowering of the rate of death and injury
- 3 to persons and property when mass transportation is utilized as
- 4 an alternative to highway use.
- 5 Section 7. Results of study.
- 6 The findings and recommendations contained in the feasibility
- 7 study shall be reported to the Joint Legislative Committee
- 8 within six months of the proposal's acceptance.
- 9 Section 8. Report to General Assembly.
- 10 The committee shall make a report of its findings to the
- 11 General Assembly together with any proposed legislation as soon
- 12 as practicable.
- 13 Section 9. Appropriation.
- 14 The sum of \$150,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary,

- 15 is hereby appropriated to the Joint Legislative Committee to
- 16 carry out this act.
- 17 Section 10 9. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect immediately.
