## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 9 10 11 elections, "providing for reimbursements to county boards of 12 elections in certain years. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 305(a) of the act of June 3, 1937 15 16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a clause to read: 17 18 Section 305. Expenses of County Boards and of Primaries and 19 Elections to Be Paid by County; Expenses of Special Elections; Boards to Be Provided with Offices. --20
- 21 (a) The county commissioners or other appropriating
- 22 authorities of the county shall appropriate annually, and from

- 1 time to time, to the county board of elections of such county,
- 2 the funds that shall be necessary for the maintenance and
- 3 operation of the board and for the conduct of primaries and
- 4 elections in such county, including the payment of the
- 5 compensation of the employes of the board, custodians, election
- 6 officers, and other assistants and employes herein provided for,
- 7 and the fees of witnesses as herein provided; for the purchase
- 8 or printing, under contracts made by the board, of all ballots
- 9 and other primary and election supplies required by this act, or
- 10 which the board shall consider necessary to carry out the
- 11 provisions of this act; for the purchase, under contracts made
- 12 by the board, and maintenance, of voting machines, when adopted
- 13 as herein provided, and of all other primary and election
- 14 equipment required by this act, or which the board shall
- 15 consider necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; for
- 16 the publication of notices authorized by this act, under
- 17 contracts made by the board, and for all other necessary
- 18 expenses hereunder: Provided, however, That bonds or other
- 19 evidences of indebtedness, payable not later than thirty years
- 20 from their dates of issuance, may be issued by the county
- 21 commissioners or other appropriating authorities of the county
- 22 in accordance with the provisions of law relating to the
- 23 increase of indebtedness of such county, to meet all or any part
- 24 of the cost of voting machines.

- 26 <u>5. The Department of State shall reimburse county boards of</u>
- 27 election fifty per centum of the cost of their operation in
- 28 years when there are only State and Federal officers to be
- 29 <u>elected</u>.
