## AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. (a) The sum of $\$ 3,673,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for its fiscal year July 1, 1983 to June 30, 1984, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program.
(b) The sum of $\$ 175,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for its fiscal year July 1, 1983 to June 30, 1984, for the general maintenance of the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, including the Allied Health, Professions and Graduate School of the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, and student aid.

Section 2. Payments to the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital on account of the appropriations provided in section 1
shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of costs during the fiscal year.

Section 3. The Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital shall provide such information as may be required to carry out the provisions of this act and in such form and manner as the Department of Education may prescribe.

Section 4. The Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975," without exception.

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1983 or, if enacted subsequent to that date, then immediately.
