AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 17, 1956 (1955 P.L.1609, No.537), 2 entitled "An act to promote the welfare of the people of the 3 Commonwealth by the reduction of unemployment in certain 4 areas of the Commonwealth determined to be critical economic areas; providing for the establishment of industrial development projects in such areas; creating The Pennsylvania 6 7 Industrial Development Authority as a body corporate and 8 politic with power to allocate funds for and make secured 9 loans to industrial development agencies for the payment of a part of the cost of industrial development projects in 10 critical economic areas; authorizing the Authority to enter 11 12 into agreements with the Government of the United States or 13 any Federal agency or industrial development agency; empowering the Authority to take title to, sell, convey and 14 15 lease industrial development projects where necessary to 16 protect loans made by the Pennsylvania Industrial Development Authority on industrial development projects; providing that 17 18 no debt of the Commonwealth, its municipalities or political 19 subdivisions shall be incurred in the exercise of any powers 20 granted by this act; and providing for the examination of the accounts and affairs of the Authority; and making an 21 22 appropriation, providing for performance audits to be 23 conducted by the Authority.
- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of May 17, 1955 (1956)
- 27 P.L.1609, No.537), known as the Pennsylvania Industrial
- 28 Development Authority Act, is amended by adding clauses to read:

- 1 Section 5. Powers of the Authority; General. -- The Authority,
- 2 as a public corporation and governmental instrumentality
- 3 exercising public powers of the Commonwealth, is hereby granted
- 4 and shall have and may exercise all powers necessary or
- 5 appropriate to carry out and effectuate the purposes of this
- 6 act, including the following powers, in addition to others
- 7 herein granted:
- 8 * * *
- 9 (s) To make loans to industrial development agencies for
- 10 industrial development projects which are conditional upon the
- 11 <u>outcome of a performance audit conducted by the Authority within</u>
- 12 the third year following the granting of any loan and to include
- 13 <u>an acceleration clause in any such loan agreement to be</u>
- 14 conditioned upon the outcome of any performance audit.
- 15 (t) To perform a performance audit conducted by the
- 16 Authority, within the third year following the granting of any
- 17 loan and to have included an acceleration clause in any such
- 18 agreement, whether or not the transaction is a local finance
- 19 transaction, and regardless of the parties involved.

- 21 Section 2. Section 7 of the act is amended by adding a
- 22 clause to read:
- 23 Section 7. Loan Application Requirements.--Prior to the
- 24 loaning of any funds to an industrial development agency for an
- 25 industrial development project in a critical economic area, the
- 26 Authority shall receive from such industrial development agency
- 27 a loan application in form adopted by the Authority which shall
- 28 contain, without being limited to, the following provisions:
- 29 * * *
- 30 (1) A general provision which provides that the signing of

- 1 the document and completion of the application shall constitute
- 2 and operate as agreement by the applicants to all of the
- 3 provisions of the loan.

- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
