AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for the placement of additional traffic-
3 control devices in school zones.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3365(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3365. Special speed limitations.

9 * * *

10 (b) School zones.--When passing a school zone as defined and
11 established under regulations of the department, no person shall
12 drive a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour. An
13 official traffic-control device shall indicate the beginning and
14 end of each school zone to traffic approaching in each
15 direction. In addition to those official traffic-control devices
16 which indicate the beginning and end of each school zone, there
17 shall be positioned, not more than every 200 feet, signs
18 indicating the continuation of the school zone to traffic

1 approaching in each direction. These signs shall also be placed
2 at every intervening intersection within the school zone.
3 Establishment of a school zone, including its location and hours
4 of operation, shall be approved by the department.

5 * * *

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
