AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," further regulating compensation.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 703 of the act of June 24, 1931
8 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
9 amended November 9, 1977 (P.L.230, No.72), is amended to read:

10 Section 703. Compensation.--Each township commissioner shall
11 receive a salary of not more than eight hundred dollars per year
12 in townships having a population of less than four thousand, not
13 more than twelve hundred dollars per year in townships having a
14 population of four thousand and more but less than ten thousand,
15 not more than fifteen hundred dollars per year in townships
16 having a population of ten thousand and more but less than
17 fifteen thousand, not more than twenty-four hundred dollars in
18 townships having a population of not less than fifteen thousand

1 and not more than twenty-five thousand, [and] not more than
2 three thousand dollars in townships having a population [in
3 excess] of twenty-five thousand and more but less than thirty
4 thousand, not more than three thousand six hundred dollars per
5 year in townships having a population of thirty thousand and
6 more but less than thirty-five thousand, not more than four
7 thousand two hundred dollars in townships having a population of
8 more than thirty-five thousand and more but less than forty
9 thousand and not more than four thousand eight hundred dollars
10 per year in townships having a population in excess of forty
11 thousand. Such salaries shall be payable monthly or quarterly
12 for the duties imposed by the provisions of this act.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
