## AN ACT

- Designating December 7 as Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day. 1
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 3
- Section 1. Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
- 5 December 7, <del>1983</del> 1984, and the same day of each succeeding
- year, is designated as Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day in this
- Commonwealth in special tribute to those members of our Armed
- Forces who lost their lives and also to those who survived the
- attack on Pearl Harbor, Territory of Hawaii, December 7, 1941.
- 10 Upon this date, in perpetuity, all citizens of this Commonwealth
- 11 and the Nation are urged to pay homage to the members of our
- Armed Forces for the manner in which they bore the attack. 12
- Section 2. Effective date. 13
- This act shall take effect immediately. 14
