AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, requiring head lamps to be illuminated while
3 windshield wipers are in operation.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4302 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 4302. Period for requiring lighted lamps.

9 Every vehicle upon a highway at any time between sunset and
10 sunrise, at any time when the windshield wipers are in operation
11 and at any other time when, due to insufficient light or
12 unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the
13 highway are not clearly discernible from a distance of 1000 feet
14 ahead shall display lighted head and other lamps and
15 illuminating devices as required under this chapter for
16 different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with
17 respect to parked vehicles. Stop lights, turn signals and other
18 signaling devices shall be lighted as prescribed in this title.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
