6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 13 of Article V be amended by adding a
9	subsection to read:
10	§ 13. Election of justices, judges and justices of the peace;
11	vacancies.

13	(f) All candidates for judicial office may freely
14	communicate their thoughts and opinions and may freely speak,
15	write and print on any subject, being responsible for any abuse
16	of that liberty, and neither the Supreme Court nor any other
17	court nor any agency, committee or unit of the unified judicial

- 1 system shall have the power to limit the right of any candidate
- 2 to present views on any legal or political issue or to limit the
- 3 <u>candidate's right to attend any lawful gathering</u>.
