## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, adding financial disclosure requirements
- 3 applying to the judiciary branch.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That the heading and subsection (b) of section 17 of Article
- 9 V be amended and a subsection be added to read:
- 10 § 17. Prohibited activities, conflicts of interest and
- 11 <u>financial disclosure</u>.

- 13 (b) Justices and judges shall not engage in any activity
- 14 prohibited by law and shall not violate any canon of legal or
- 15 judicial ethics prescribed by the Supreme Court or the General
- 16 Assembly by law. Justices of the peace shall be governed by
- 17 rules or canons which shall be prescribed by the Supreme Court.

- 2 (e) All justices, judges, justices of the peace and other
- 3 officers or employees of the unified judicial system shall be
- 4 required to meet such financial disclosure requirements as the
- 5 General Assembly by law may provide and shall be subject to such
- 6 prohibitions on conflicts of interest as the General Assembly by
- 7 law may provide. Nothing in this subsection shall limit the
- 8 power of the Supreme Court to require financial disclosure in
- 9 <u>addition to that provided by law or to further prohibit</u>
- 10 <u>conflicts of interest.</u>
