AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for restitution for the  
3 theft of standing timber.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1107. Restitution for theft of timber.

9 Any person convicted for the theft of standing timber under  
10 section 3921 (relating to theft by unlawful taking or  
11 disposition) shall, in addition to any other sentence imposed,  
12 be sentenced to pay the owner of the timber restitution in an  
13 amount twice the value of the timber taken.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
