## AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations from a restricted revenue account within
- 2 the General Fund to the Department of State for use by the
- 3 Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$7,935,000 \$8,935,000, or as much <—
- 7 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
- 8 Professional Licensure Augmentation Restricted Revenue Account
- 9 within the General Fund to the Department of State to augment
- 10 the general government appropriation for the operation of the
- 11 Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs for the fiscal
- 12 year July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985.
- 13 (b) The sum of \$525,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Professional
- 15 Licensure Augmentation Restricted Revenue Account within the
- 16 General Fund to the Department of State to augment the general
- 17 government appropriation for the operation of the State

- 1 Registration Board of Professional Engineers for the fiscal year
- 2 July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985. Funds from this appropriation may
- 3 be used to fund test sites, travel expenses, consultant fees and
- 4 newsletter expenses at the discretion of the State Registration
- 5 Board for Professional Engineers.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1984 or, if
- 7 enacted subsequent to that date, then immediately.
