AN ACT

Amending the act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), entitled "An 2 act providing for the incorporation as bodies corporate and 3 politic of "Authorities" for municipalities, counties and townships; prescribing the rights, powers and duties of such 5 Authorities heretofore or hereafter incorporated; authorizing 6 such Authorities to acquire, construct, improve, maintain and 7 operate projects, and to borrow money and issue bonds 8 therefor; providing for the payment of such bonds, and prescribing the rights of the holders thereof; conferring the 9 right of eminent domain on such Authorities; authorizing such 10 11 Authorities to enter into contracts with and to accept grants 12 from the Federal Government or any agency thereof; and 13 conferring exclusive jurisdiction on certain courts over 14 rates, " requiring the submission of budgets and reports. 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 17 Section 1. Section 4 of the act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), known as the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, is 18 19 amended by adding a subsection to read: 20 Section 4. Purposes and Powers; General. -- * * * 21 F. Every authority shall submit annually a proposed budget for the coming year to the municipality or municipalities that 22

created it for review and comments. Each authority shall also

- 1 submit quarterly reports to the creating municipality or
- 2 <u>municipalities on its activities during the preceding quarter.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days. 3
