AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An 2 act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste 3 storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment, and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for 4 5 municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions; 6 authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of 7 the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste; 8 requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid 9 waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal 10 facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous 11 waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities; granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the 12 13 Environmental Quality Board and the Department of 14 Environmental Resources to adopt rules, regulations, standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing 15 duties upon county health departments; providing remedies; 16 17 prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund, "prohibiting 18 the operation of disposal sites in the vicinity of certain 19 rivers.
- 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 21 hereby enacts as follows:
- 22 Section 1. The act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known
- 23 as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by adding a
- 24 section to read:
- 25 Section 508. Solid waste disposal sites near rivers.
- The department shall not permit the operation of a solid

- waste disposal site which has boundaries within 500 feet of a 1
- 2 <u>river if a municipal water system or authority draws its water</u>
- 3 supply from the river at a distance of less than five miles from
- 4 the solid waste disposal site.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
