## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 1 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), 2 entitled 'An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 4 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 5 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative б departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 7 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 8 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 9 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 12 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 13 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 15 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 16 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 17 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 19 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 20 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined, ' implementing the addition 21 22 of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 23 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 24 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General 26 Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 27 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 28 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 29 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 30 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," 31 further providing for the duties of the General Counsel 32 regarding review of proposed rules or regulations.

33 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

hereby enacts as follows: 1

2 Section 1. Section 301(10) of the act of October 15, 1980 3 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is 4 amended to read:

5 Section 301. General Counsel.

There is hereby established the Office of General Counsel 6 which shall be headed by a General Counsel appointed by the 7 8 Governor to serve at his pleasure who shall be the legal advisor 9 to the Governor and who shall:

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(10) Review and approve for form and legality all 11 12 proposed rules and regulations of executive agencies before 13 they are deposited with the Legislative Reference Bureau as required by section 207 of the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, 14 15 No.240), known as the "Commonwealth Documents Law." The 16 General Counsel shall have 30 days from receipt of a proposed rule or regulation to approve or disapprove the rule or 17 18 regulation. The approval or disapproval and reasons therefor shall be transmitted to the affected agency within 30 days of 19 20 initial receipt of the rule or regulation by the General 21 Counsel. \* \* \* 22

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Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
